ORDINANCE NO. 889

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE FOOTING OF SIGNS, BILLS, POSTERS, OR OTHER ADVERTISING MATTER ON BUILDINGS, POSTS, TARMS OR OTHER PREMISES IN THE CITY OF ALBAMY, ORSON.

THE PROFILE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AT FOLIOWS:

post any sign . bill, poster, or other advertising matter on any building, post, tree, fence or other premises in the City of Albany, Oregon, unless such person or persons shall have first obtained permission of the owner or person in control of such premises.

Fection 2. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinances shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$10.00 or shall be imprisoned in the City Jail not less than two days nor more than five days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.
