AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE FROBABLE COFT OF CENTALE IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OLDOW, HAS DETERMINED IN EXPOLUTION NO. 7 ADOPTED BY BAID COUNCIL OF THE TITE DAY OF AURIL 1917, TO MAKE ON BAKER STREET MROW THE SOUTH LINK OF THIRD STREET TO THE NORTH LINE OF NIMIN STREET: TO ASCRITATE, ASSESS, DETERMINE AVE DEGLARE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF FUCH PROBABLE COST OF BUCH INTROVMENT OF EAST BAKER STREET THAT IS ASSESSED UPON EACH LOT ON PART THREEDY ADJAGREE TO CAID FART OF HATD BAKER STREET TO BE CO THUROVER: "O DIAMET THE ERCORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATSFERT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIMB AF PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS on the 27th day of March 1917, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of meth lity to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Baker Street from the South line of Third Street to the North line of Rinth Street in said City of Albany by grading said street to the established grade and paying the same with asphaltic concrete paying upon a bituminous concrete base, and for the construction of consists curbing where ever necessary, and the installing of a proper drainage system, and for estimates of the work to he done on the said portion of Paker Afreet and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plane, specifications, estimates, and probable cost be filed in the office of the hemorder of enid City , said resolutions being endorsed, "Resolution No. 5" and adopted the 27th day of March 1917.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to anid resolution No.5 made plane, specifications and estimates as directed by said resolution for the improvement of said Baker Street in the manner specified in anid resolution No.5, and filed said plane, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 10th day of April, 1917.

WHEREAS, the said Council on the 11th day of April, 1917 by Resolution No. 7 Maly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said foundil proposed to improve Baker "treet from the South line of Third Street to the North line of Kinth Street in the manner provided in said Resolution "o.7, to-wit:

Pirst: "y grading said street to the proper subgrade.
Second: By paving the rondway of said street full width with full
intersections, with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltale concrete foundation

laying and constructing apphaltic concrete headers.

Third : By Fourth: By constructing entch basing.

WHEREAS, "he Council in and by said Resolution Ho.? aggertained and determined the total probable cost of making said lastrovement of said Baker Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Baker Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution 110.7 to be the sum of \$8423.30.

THEREFORK

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBARY DO ORDAIN AS VOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Taker Street in the Sity of Albany, Oregon, from the South line of Third Street to the North line of Ninth Street, shall be improved as follows:

First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade. Cecond: By paving the rondway of said street full width with full intercentions, with asymptotic concrete pavement onm nerhaltic concrete foundation.
Third: By laying and constructing amphaltic concrete headers.

Pourth: By constructing catch basins.
Pifth: By constructing inlets.
Sixth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

all in accordance with resolution No.7 and the plane and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 10th day of April, 1917.

Section D. That the probable cost of making said impro vements of said Paker Street in the City of Albany from the South line of Third Street to the Forth line of Einth Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by resolution No.7 with asphaltic concrete payement to be paid by the owners or the real property adjacent to said portion of Bakor Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$8423.30.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Baker Ctreet appressed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Baker Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said regolution to.? is hereby necertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the seperate description of each of such lots or narts thereof as follows:
