## ORDINANCE NO 401

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND LECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORROOM, TO RETER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PRANCES M. TRAVIS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF BAKER STREET THOM THE SOUTH LINE OF THIRD STREET TO THE NORTH LINE OF HINTH STREET IN SAID CITY

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No., 387 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: Baker Etreet from the South line of Third Street to the North Time of Ninth Street, be improved in the following menner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
Bedond: By paving the roadway of said effect full width with
full interspections with apphaltic concrete pavement
on an asphaltic concrete foundation.

Third: By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete headers. Fourth: By constructing catch basins. Fifth: By constructing inlets.

Sixth : By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

said improvement to be made in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS, it was provided in suid ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany, give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisoment for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the Ordinance lest aforesaid, to-wit: on the 23rd day of May, 1917, Frances M. Travis presented to the Council of the City of Albany, bid for making said improvement with Asphaltic Concrete Payement, which said bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid the said Frances M. Travis proposed to furnish all the material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with annhaltic concrete pavement for the following named prices, to-wit:

AND WHIREAR, said Frances W. Travir was the lowest bidder for the said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor.

> THEREFORE THE PROPIE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS MILLOWS: Section 1. That the bid of Frances M. Travts for said improvement

of Baker fitreet from the South line of Third Ctreet to the North line of Ninth Ctreet with Asphaltic Concrete Favement be and the same is hereby addepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contrast in writing with the said Frances W. Travis for the making of said improvement with Asphaltic Concrete Pavement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that the work of said improvement shall commonse within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work enhanced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the fifteenth day of July, 1917, unless further time be extended by the founcil of said fity, and the City of Albany, Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$25,00 per day for each and every day the said work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the said Frances M. Travis furnish a bond in the sum of \$4,650,00 to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, having as a surety thereon a surety company, authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of the said Frances M. Travis, and further indemnifying the flity of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.
