AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 57 OF ORDINANCE

MO. 663, ENTITIED, "AN ORDINANCE REQULATING THE

CONSTRUCTION, ERECTION, HAISING, LOWERING, ALTER
ATION; REPAIR AND USE OF BUILDINGS AND TO PROVIDE

WOR PROTECTION AGAINST FIRE AND TO REPEAL ALL OED
INANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONTILCT WITH

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE ", PASSED BY "HE

COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALPANY, ORTGON, ADELL 28TH,

1913, ARB APPROVED BY THE MAYOR OF SAIL CITY APRIL 28TH, 1913.

THE PROFIE OF THE CITY OF ALBARY DO ORDAIN AS POLLOWS:

Section 1. That section 57 of Ordinance Fo. 633, entitled,
"An ordinance regulating the construction, erection, raising, lowering,
alteration, repair and use of buildings and to provide for protection
against fires and to repeal all ordinances in conflict with the provisions
of this ordinance," passed by the Council of the City of Albny, Oregon,
April 28th, 1913, and approved by the Enyor of said City April 28th, 1913,
be and the same is hereby amended to rend as follows:

Section 57. Every building hereafter erected within the fire limits 'shall be constructed in accordace with the requirements of this ordinance for the construction of buildings of either class "A", class "B", or class "C" except dwellings or flats not exceeding two stories in height, or one story business houses not exceeding twenty (20) feet in width, forty (40) feet in length and fourteen (14) feet in height, outside wall of which may be constructed of concrete blocks or brick or their equivalent, eight (8) inches in thickness, and permission is hereby granted for the construction of buildings upon property abutting Lyon Street to be used solely for residence purposes and of the value of \$2,000.00 or more for each building, and to alter, raise, lower or repair any dwelling now arceted on said street, provided that before the commencement of the work of constructing, altering, raising, larging, or repairing of any building on said Lyon Street for resident purposes the person, firm, or corporation doing such work shall file wit the City Recorder plans and specifications of the proposed work together with an application in writing for permission to proceed, which application shall be referred to the Committee on Fire and Water and shall be sated upon by said Committee in like manner as that eet forth in Section 1 of this ordinance.
