

ORDINANCE NO. 895

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE ONE HUNDRED FIFTY (\$150.00) DOLLARS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A BITULITHIC MELTING POT.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon the sum of One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars for the purpose of purchasing a Bitulithic Melting Pot for said City, and the Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the general funds of said City for said amount in favor of Albany Iron Works in payment thereof.


