AN ORDINACE AUTHORIZING THE WAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY TO INTEL THEO A CONTRACT WITH W. S. WWAVER FOR THE BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION OF A LATERAL SEWER BEGINNING AT THE MANHOLE IN THE OAK OTHERT THUNK SEWAR BRIWKEN SAUTIAN AND SALEM ROADS AND LUNWING THENCE EASTERLY ACROSS BLOCKS TWO (2) AND ONE (1) OF ABBEY'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF AUTINY, ORESON: ALSO RETURNS THROUGH THE OTTER OF BLOCK TWO (2) OF SAID ADDITION PROV THE SOUTH LINE OF SALES ROAD TO THE WORTH TIME OF THE OREGON HENCTRIC RAIL-WAY COMMANY'S RIGHT OF WAY; AND ALSO DURING ALONG THE BASTERN BUMBARY TINE OF BLOCK OUR (1) OF SAID ADDITION TROM THE SOUTH JAYE OF SATE MOAT TO THE NORTH LIST OF OREGON MUNOTAIR RAILWAY CONTINUE RICHT OF MAY, WITH VITRIFIED THEAA COTTA SEMEN FIRE, ACCORDING TO THE ATENDED PLANE AND SPECIFICATION TILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE RICORDER OF THE CITY OF ALHANY, OHROON, ON APRIL 10th, 1917.

WHENEARS, by Assolution No.8 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the Council of said City on the 11th day of April, 1917 it was ordered that a lateral sewer be constructed beginning at the manhole in the Cak Ctreet Trunk Sewer between Canting and Salem Roads and running thence Easterly scross Blocks two (2) and one (1) of Abbey's Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon; also running through the center of Block two (2) of said Addition from the South line of Salem Road to the Borth line of the Oregon Electric Asilway Company's right of way; and also lunning form the South line of Calem Road to the Borth line of the Oregon Electric Railway Company's right of way, and improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany, and the plans, creeffications and ostimates of the City Engineer, then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS it was provided by ordinance that the hedorder of the fity of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance, and

WHELEAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Records, of the City of Albany, Oregon, according to said ordinance, on the 13th day of June, 1917, W. R. Weaver presented his bid to the Council of said City for the making of said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the condition imposed by law and by said ordinance, by which bid the case w. S. Weaver proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the lawor necessary to make the above described improvement, for the sum of 1814.10; and

WHEREAS, W. R. Wenver was the lowest bidder for said proposed work, and enid bid was the lowest and best bid therefor;

WHERE WOLL A

THE PROPER OF THE GITY OF ATRACE DO CHARTE AS TOLICES:

Section 1. That the bid of the said W. S. Wenver for said improvement he and the same is hereby accepted, and the "myor and Recorder of the Bity of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing " with the said ". S. Weaver for the anking a word improvement, as aforenaid. on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, and upon the terms and conditions in anid ordinance, advertisement and bid hereinsbove mentioned. Raid contract shall provide that the work on said sewer shall commence within ten (10) days after the signing of gaid contract, and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work ambraced in said contract, shall be entirely completed on or before th lot day of August, 1917; and the City of Albany, Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$5.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said . specified time.

Said contract shall further proved the the said W. S. Weaver shall promptly, as'due, make payment to all persons supplying to the said w, 8, Warver Inboramaterial for the prosecution of the hereinabove described work, and that the said W. M. Weaver shall not permit any lien or claim to be filed or prosocuted against the City of Albany for or anaccount of said labor or material furnished for the said work.

The said W. S. Weaver shall furnish a penal bond in the sum of \$400.00 with good and sufficient sureties to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, to secure the faithful performance of all the obligations of the part of eaid W. S. Weaver and particulary against such dontract or any claim or lied for labor, work or material on the part of any person arising out of said contract.
