ORDINANCE NO. 101

AN ORDINANCE TO DEWERRING THE PROBABLE COST OF CHRITATN IMPROVINITIES WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORKSON, TO THE THE TELEVISION OF THE TOURS OF THE CONTINUENCE OF THE CONTINUEN MALL WAR BAR BUT UN WAY. TOTS. WE SAKE OR WHE VILL AT IN MINCH NO. , 3 OF THE GITY OF ALPANY, BRESON, FROM THE WEST LINE OF PERRY STREET TO THE MAST LINE OF WASHINGTON STREET: TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DESTARE THE PROPORTIONALE SHARE OF SHOR PRODATES COST OF CUCH INTRODUCTION OF BATC ALLEY THAT IS ASSESSED UPON BACH LOT OR TART THEREOF AD-JACKET TO SAID PART OF SAID ALLEY TO THE SO IMPROVED: AND TO DIRROT THE RECORDER OF SAID STTY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF BUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOOKED OF CITY LITTE AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS on the 23rd day of May, 1917, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of gaid Sity to make plans and specifications for the improvement of the Alley on Block No., 3 of the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West line of Ferry Street to the East line of Washington Street in said City, by grading said Alley to the established grade and naving the same with Asphaltic Concrete Paying upon a bituminous concrete base, and for the construction of concrete curbing whereever necessary, and the installing of a proper drainage system, and for estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said Alley and the probable cost thereof, and requiring that such plans specifications, estimates, and probable cost be filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 9th day of May, 1917, said resolution being endorsed, "Resolution No., 9, wighted, May 23rd, 1917"; and

WHEREAS. The City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said resolution No., 9 made plans, apecifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said lity of the "3rd day o" "ay, 1917; and

WREE AS, the said Council on the 23rd day of May, 1717 by Resolution No. 10 duly adonted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve the Alley in Block No., 3 of the City of Albany from the West line of Ferry Street to the Rast line of Washington Street in the manner provided in said resolution No., 10 to-wit:

> By grading and alley to the proper subgrade. Ty raving the roadway of said alley full width with apphaltic concrete pavesent on an asphaltic concrete First : Second

foundation. Third : Py laying and constructing asphaltic concrete and wood headars

Fourth: By constructing inlets. Fifth: By laying vitrified sover pine.

AND WHILKES, the Recorder, in pursuance of said Resolution No. 10 adopted as aforesaid by the Council of enid City of Albany, did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said portion of said Alley

in the manner provided by the Charter of said City; and

WHEREAS, The Council in and by said Resolution No. ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of unid Alley to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Alley to be improved as specified in said Resolution No., 10 to be the sum of \$954,45.

THEREPORK

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBATY DO GENALT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Alley in Block Wo., 3 of the City of Albany. Oregon, from the West line of Ferry Street to the East line of Washington. Stroet, shall be improved as follows.

First: By grading said Alley to the proper cubgrade. Second: By paving the roadway of said alley full width with asphaltin concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.

Third : By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete wood headers.

Fourth: By constructing inlets. Fifth: By laying vitrified sover pipe.

all in accordance with resolution No. 10 and the plans and epocifications for said improvement filed by the dity Engineer with the Lecorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 23rd day of May, 1917.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Alley in Block No. 3 of the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West line of Ferry Street to the East line of Washington Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by resolution No. 10 with sanhaltic concrete pavement to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Alley is hereby declared to be the sum of \$354.45.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cort of said improvement of said Alley assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Alley so to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by the Council in and by said resolution No. 10 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sumanni placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
