

ORDINANCE No. 201

AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, HAS DETERMINED BY RESOLUTION NO., 8 ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 9TH DAY OF MAY, 1917, TO MAKE OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK NO., 3 OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, FROM THE WEST LINE OF FERRY STREET TO THE EAST LINE OF WASHINGTON STREET; TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROBABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID ALLEY THAT IS ASSESSED UPON EACH LOT OR PART THEREOF ADJACENT TO SAID PART OF SAID ALLEY TO BE SO IMPROVED; AND TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LINES AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS on the 23rd day of May, 1917, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of the Alley on Block No., 3 of the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West line of Ferry Street to the East line of Washington Street in said City, by grading said Alley to the established grade and paving the same with Asphaltic Concrete Paving upon a bituminous concrete base, and for the construction of concrete curbing wherever necessary, and the installing of a proper drainage system, and for estimation of the work to be done on said portion of said Alley and the probable cost thereof, and requiring that such plans specifications, estimates, and probable cost be filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 9th day of May, 1917, said resolution being endorsed, "Resolution No., 9, adopted, May 23rd, 1917"; and

WHEREAS, The City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said resolution No., 9 made plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 23rd day of May, 1917; and

WHEREAS, the said Council on the 23rd day of May, 1917 by Resolution No. 10 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve the Alley in Block No., 3 of the City of Albany from the West line of Ferry Street to the East line of Washington Street in the manner provided in said resolution No., 10 to-wit:

- First : By grading said alley to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said alley full width with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.
- Third : By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete and wood headers.
- Fourth: By constructing inlets.
- Fifth : By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

AND WHEREAS, the Recorder, in pursuance of said Resolution No. 10 adopted as aforesaid by the Council of said City of Albany, did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said portion of said Alley

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in the manner provided by the Charter of said City; and

WHEREAS, The Council in and by said Resolution No. ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Alley to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Alley to be improved as specified in said Resolution No., 10 to be the sum of \$954.45.

THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Alley in Block No., 3 of the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West line of Ferry Street to the East line of Washington Street, shall be improved as follows.

- First : By grading said Alley to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said alley full width with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.
- Third : By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete wood headers.
- Fourth: By constructing inlets.
- Fifth : By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

all in accordance with resolution No. 10 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 23rd day of May, 1917.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Alley in Block No. 3 of the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West line of Ferry Street to the East line of Washington Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by resolution No. 10 with asphaltic concrete pavement to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Alley is hereby declared to be the sum of \$954.45.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Alley assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Alley so to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by the Council in and by said resolution No. 10 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum ^{set} and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
