

ORDINANCE NO. 902

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FRANCES M. TRAVIS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 3 OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, FROM THE WEST LINE OF FERRY STREET TO THE EAST LINE OF WASHINGTON STREET IN SAID CITY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, by ordinance No., 901 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following alley in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: Alley in Block No. 3 of the City of Albany from the West line of Ferry Street to the East line of Washington Street, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First : By grading said alley to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said alley full width with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.
- Third : By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete and wood headers.
- Fourth. By constructing inlets.
- Fifth : By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates of the City Engineer then on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the Ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit: on the 27th day of June, 1917, Frances M. Travis presented to the Council of the City of Albany, her bid for making said improvement with Asphaltic Concrete Pavement, which said bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid the said Frances M. Travis proposed to furnish all the material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with asphaltic concrete pavement for the following named prices, to-wit:

Excavation per cubic yard	\$.70
Fill or embankment per cubic yard	\$.25
Asphaltic concrete surface, including the surface finishing course and foundation complete, per square yard	\$ 1.18
Six inch sewer pipe, per lineal foot	\$.55
Inlets, Style "C", each	\$20.00
Paving headers, per lineal foot, concrete	\$.35
Tapping lateral and main sewer.	\$ 3.00
Paving headers, wooden, per lineal foot	\$.02

AND WHEREAS, said Frances M. Travis was the lowest bidder for the said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor:

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of Frances M. Travis for said improvement of the Alley in Block No. 3 of the City of Albany from the West line of Ferry Street

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to the East line of Washington Street with asphaltic concrete pavement
be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City
of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with
the said Frances M. Travis for the making of said improvement with asphaltic
concrete pavement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms
mentioned in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that the work of said improvement
shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall
be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract
shall be entirely completed on or before the 1st day of August, 1917, unless
further time be extended by the Council of said City, and the City of Albany,
Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$10.00 per day
for each and every day the said work is delayed beyond said specified time,
and that the said Frances M. Travis, furnish a bond in the sum of \$500.00
to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditioned
for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of the said
Frances M. Travis, and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any
claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm
or corporation, arising out of said contract.
