## ORDINANCE NO. 202

AN ORDINAUCE AUTHORIZING THE WAYOR AND ERCORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORROON, TO ENTER INTO A COUTHACT WITH PRANCIC E. PRANCO FOR THE THEROVINGE OF THE ARLEY IN BLOCK 3 OF THE CITY OF AUBARY, ORMOON, PROM THE WEST LINE OF PERRY STREET TO THE EAST LINE OF WASHINGTON BTREET IN SAID CITY.

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHERMAS by ordinance Wo., 961 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following alley in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: "Alley in Blook Wo. 3 of the City of Albany from the West line of Terry Street to the "agt line of "ashington Street, he improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said alloy to the proper subgrade.

Second: By paving the roadway of said alley full width with apphaltic concrete pavement on an apphaltic concrete foundation. Third : By laying and constructing amphaltic concrete and wood headers. Fifth: Ty laying vitrified samer pipe.

"All improvement to be and, in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates of the City Ingineer then on file in the office of the lecorder of the City of Albany; and

"FEREAS, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

WHENEXAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the Ordinance lest aforesaid, to-wit; on the 27th day of June, 1917, Frances ". Travis treeented to the Council of the City of Albany, her bid for making said improvement with Asphaltic Concrete Favement, which said bid was made in due for m and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid the said Frances W. Travis proposed to furnish all the material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with apphaltic concrete pavement for the following named prices, to-wit:

THEREFORE THE PROFILE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO URDAIN AS TOLIOWS: Section 1. That the bid of Frances M. Travis for said improvement of the Allay in Block No. 3 of the City of Albany from the West line of Farry Etraet

to the list line of Washington Street with apphaltic concrete payment be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Remorder of said City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Transes W. Travis for the making of said improvement with asphaltic concrete payment on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid hereinshove mentioned.

Paid contract to provide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be presecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the lat day of August, 1917, unless further time be extended by the Council of said City, and the City of Albany, Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$10.00 per day for each and every day the said work in delayed beyond said specified time, and that the said Trances F. Travia, Surnish a bond in the sum of \$500.00 to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of the paid contract on the part of the said Frances E. Travia, and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.
