ORDINANCE NO. 904

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A SURPLUS ON ASSEMBLY OF THE IMPROVE-MENT MADE BY FRANCER H. TRAVES OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK NO. 3 OF THE CITY OF ALBANY PROMITES WEST LINE OF PERMY STREET TO THE MAST LINE OF WASHINGTON STANKT IN SAID CITY AND DIRECTING THE RECORDER TO PLACE TO THE CARDIT OF THE SEVERAL OWNERS OF THE VARIOUS PARCELS OF REAL ESTATE, ADJACRET TO SAID IMPROVEMENT. HIGHTO FORK ASSESSED AND ENTERED OF RECORD IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIENS IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, CARROW, FOR MAKING BUCH IMPROVEDENT. THEIR PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH SURPLUS.

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a surplus of 7.27 per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon, and Frances M. Travis for the improvement of the Alley in Block No., 3 of the City of Albany, Oregon from the West line of Ferry Street to the East line of Washington Street, and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate adjacent to said improvement Horeto-Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed

to enter in the Docket of City Liens in the surplus column thereof, a credit of 7.27 per cent, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of improving said portion of said street, said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, owners or reputed owners of such parcels of real estate and in the sums as follows to-wit;
