AN ORDINANCE TO ANALO EXCITOR 5 OF ORDINANCE NO.,
699 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO REQULARE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT
OF THE CITY OF ALPANY ARE TO REMEAL ALL ACTS AND PARTS OF
ACTS IN COURLECT THERESITHS, FACEED BY THE COURCIL DECIMBER 10TH, 1913 AND APPROVED DECEMBER 10TH, 1913.

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBAIT DO ORDAIN AS POLITIMS:

That Section 5 of Ordinance No., 699 entitled, "An Ordinance to regulate the fire department of the City of Albany and to repeal all acts and parts of sats in conflict therewith", bassed by the Council December 10th, 1913 and Approved December 10th, 1913 be and the same is hereby smended to read as follows, to wait:

Section 5. The chief engineer shall receive an annual salary of \$200.00 which shall be paid quarterly out of the treasury, the same as other claims against the City are paid, provided that in case the chief ingineer shall be absent from the City during his term of office, during the time of such absence such salary shall be paid to the assistant engineer as other claims against the City are paid and shall be deducted from the salary of the chief engineer. The salary of the engine man shall be \$90.00 per month, payable monthly out of the City mreasury as other claims are paid. The salary of the auto driver shall be \$75.00 per month payable monthly as other claims against the City are paid. The salary of the Assistant engineer and the six firemen shall be \$15.00 per month payable quartly as other claims against the City are made.

Passed by the Council September 12th, 1917. Approved by the Mayor September 13th, 1917.
