

ORDINANCE NO. 966

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO., 699 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF ALBANY AND TO REPEAL ALL ACTS AND PARTS OF ACTS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH", PASSED BY THE COUNCIL DECEMBER 10TH, 1913 AND APPROVED DECEMBER 10TH, 1913.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 5 of Ordinance No., 699 entitled, "An Ordinance to regulate the fire department of the City of Albany and to repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict therewith", passed by the Council December 10th, 1913 and approved December 10th, 1913 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 5. The chief engineer shall receive an annual salary of \$200.00 which shall be paid quarterly out of the treasury, the same as other claims against the City are paid, provided that in case the chief engineer shall be absent from the City during his term of office, during the time of such absence such salary shall be paid to the assistant engineer as other claims against the City are paid and shall be deducted from the salary of the chief engineer. The salary of the engine man shall be \$90.00 per month, payable monthly out of the City treasury as other claims are paid. The salary of the auto driver shall be \$75.00 per month payable monthly as other claims against the City are paid. The salary of the Assistant engineer and the six firemen shall be \$15.00 per month payable quarterly as other claims against the City are made.
