

ORDINANCE No. 907

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE THREE HUNDRED (\$300.00) DOLLARS OF THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE FIFTH COMPANY COAST ARTILLERY CORPS U.S.A.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the City of Albany, Oregon the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars for the use and benefit of the Fifth Company Coast Artillery Corps, U.S.A., and the Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant against the general fund of said City for the amount aforesaid and in favor of the said Company.

Approved by the Mayor September 26, 1917.


