

ORDINANCE NO. 209

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 894 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE, TAX AND REGULATE VEHICLES AND HAULING IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF", PASSED BY THE COUNCIL DECEMBER 27TH, 1916 AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR DECEMBER 27TH, 1916.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That ordinance number 894 entitled, "An ordinance to license, tax and regulate vehicles and hauling in the City of Albany, Oregon, and to provide a penalty for violation thereof", passed by the Council December 27th, 1916 and approved by the Mayor December 27th, 1916 be and the same is hereby amended by adding another section thereto to be numbered "Section 14", which section shall read as follows:

Section 14. All licenses issued as quarterly licenses shall expire on the last day of each quarter, viz., 31st day of March, 30th day of June, 30th day of September, and the 31st day of December of each year, and all quarterly licenses shall be dated from the first day of the month in which the liability therefor accrued and shall be issued upon the payment of a sum proportionate to the whole amount required for such license per quarter, provided that no license shall be issued for a longer period than December 31st of the year in which the same is issued.
