ORDINANCE NO. ...

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE RUBNING OF LOCUMATIVE RATEGOAD TRAINS, ELECTRIC GARD AD ELECTRIC TRAINS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIBITS OF THE CITY OF ALBARY, ORROW, AND PROVIDING A FIGURAL FOR VIDIATION THEREOF.

THE PROTES OF THE CITY OF ALBANY TO ORDADIL AS POLICUS:

Section 1. Any person or persons running, conducting or managing a locomotive electric train within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, shall sound a bell, going of other signal while approaching any street intersection in shid sity between the hours of 6 officek A.M. and 11 o'clock F.M.

Section 2. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdementor and upon conviction thereof before the Assorder's Court shall be numished by a fine of not less that \$5.00 or not more than \$20.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than two days nor more than ten days.
