# ORDINANCE NO. 909

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE RUNNING OF LOCOMOTIVE RAILROAD TRAINS, ELECTRIC CARS AND ELECTRIC TRAINS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Any person or persons running, conducting or managing a locomotive railroad train, <sup>electric car or</sup> electric train within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, shall sound a bell, gong or other signal while approaching any street intersection in said city between the hours of 6 o'clock A.M. and 11 o'clock P.M.

Section 2. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 or not more than \$20.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than two days nor more than ten days.
