AN ORDINANCE "TORUTING AND APPROVING THE TAVEMENT MADE BY SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY ON THE STREET RAILOITY OF ALBANY FROM WHICH IT HAS REMOVED ITS STREET RAILWAY TRACKS, AND ACCRETING AND APPROVING OF THE RELIMQUISHMENT
ON THE PART OF SOUTHERN PACIFIC CONTANY OF ALL PRANCISE RIGHTS
GRANTED ITS FREDECESSOR IN INTEREST BY ORDINAMEN TO, 479 OF
THE CITY OF AMBANY, AND RELIEVING SAID SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY
OF ALL OBLIGATIONS THERE UNDER.

THEREAS, on "my 24th, 1000, the Common Council of the City of Albany preseds and on May 25th, 1909, the Mayor of said city of Albany approved Ordinance No. 478 granting to Portland, Bugene & Mastern Railway Company, its successors and on enid streets assigns, a francise to construct and maintain certain street railway tracks in the nity of Albany, Oregan; and

WHITERS, cortain lines of track were laid upon certain of the streets of the said city of Albany under the terms of said ordinance and francise; and

WHEREAE, Southern Facific Company is now and for some time has been the successor in interest to all the rights granted to said Tortland, Mugene & Eastern Railway Company by said Ordinance No. 476, and has completed the removal from the streets of the city of Albany of all street railway tracks under the authority of said Ordinance and Practice, and has satisfactority replaced the revenuent of all prived streets and re-surfaced all unnaved streets in full conformity with fection 8 of said Ordinance No. 478 and to be relieved from all obligations placed upon it by the terms of said Ordinance No. 473 and to be relieved from all obligations placed upon it by the terms of said Ordinance No. 478, Now Therefore

THE PROFER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS POLLOWS:

Section 1. That the pavement laid by Southern Pacific Company upon all of the streets of Albany from which it has removed its street railway tracks, be and the same is hereby accepted and approved by the City of Albany and in consideration of the reliablement by said Southern Pacific Company of all rights granted to it under Ordinance so. 47% of the City of Albany, and Southern Pacific Company is hereby reliansed from all obligations placed upon it by the terms and conditions of said Ordinance so. 47%.
