ORDINANCE NO. 219

AN ORDINANCE TO PROMIBIT ANY ALIRN CHIMMEN PRESON OR PERSONS, FORM IMPLOYING, HIRING OR PAREOLING WHITE FREALK PERSONS IN STORES, HOMERO, SHOPS, RESTABLISHMENTS, LAUNDRIES OF OTHER PETABLISHMENTS OWNED OR OTHER TED BY SUCH CHIMESE WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORECON, AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THISHEOF.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any slien Chinese person or persons who may be the owner or manager or in control of any store, shop, house, restaurant, laundry or other establishment or enterprise within the City of Albany, Oregon, to employ: hire or harbor in or about such premises any white female person or persons either as partner, lessee, lessor, employee or in any other capacity whatsever.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction theref before the Records er's Court shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than five nor more than twenty-five days or hy both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
