## ORDINANCE NO. 920.

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00)

DOLLARS OF THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORECON,

TO ASSIST IN DEFRAYING THE EXPENSION OF ENTERTAINING THE

STATE ENCAMPMENT G. A. R. OF OREGON, TO BE HELD IN ALBANY

ON MAY 13, 14 AND 15,1918.

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Rection 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated of the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of Two Hundred (\$200,00) Dollars for the gurpose of assisting in the entertainment of the State encampment C. A. R., of Gregon, which encampent will be held in said City of Albany on May 13, 14, and 15, 1918.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant against the general funds of said city for the amount hereby appropriated and in favor of "oPherson Post No. 5, G, A, R., of Albany, Oregon, to be used by said MePherson for the purposes hereinabove set forth.
