ORDINANCE NO. 321

A N ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE TURBER 599
OF THE CITY OF ALBANY OREGON, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF ALBANY AND REPEAL
ALL ACTE AND PARTE OF ACTO IN CONFLICT THEREWITH", PASSED BY
THE COUNCIL OF SAID CITY DECEMBER 10TH, 1913, AND APPROVED
DECEMBER 10th, 1913, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS
OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Bection 1. That Section 5 of ordinance number 699 of the City of Albany, Oregon, entitled, "An'Ordinance to regulate the fire department of the City of Albany and repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict therewith", passed by the Council of said city December 10th, 1913, and approved December 10th, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended to read ap follows:

Section 5.

The chief engineer shall receive an annual salary of \$200.00 which shall be paid quarterly out of the treasury, the same as other claims against the City are paid, provided that in case the chief engineer shall be absent from the City during his term of office, during the time of such absence such salary shall be paid to the assistant engineer as other claims against the City and shall be deducted from the salary of the chief engineer. The salary of the engine man shall be \$125.00 per month payable monthly out of the City Treasury as other claims are paid. The salary of the auto driver shall be \$90.00 per month payable monthly as other claims against the City are paid. The salary of the assistant engineer and the six firemen shall be \$15.00 per month payable quarterly as other claims against the City are paid.

Bection 2. That all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance in conflict with this are horoby repealed.
