ORDINANCE NO. 384

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISPLAY OF ENGISTRATION MUMBER PLATES ON MOTOR VEHICLES AND A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION HERKOF.

THE PROTER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS POLLOWS;

Section 1. No person shall operate or drive an automobile, auto-truck, motorsyste or other motor vehicle upon the ronds, streets, avenues or alleys within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, unless such vehicle shall have the registration number plates assigned to it by the State of Oregon conspicuously displayed on the front and rear of such vehicle in plain view and so as to be casily read by the public; and it shall be unlawful to display more than one registration number upon the front or rear of any vehicle, or any number which does not entitle. the holder thereof to operate such vehicle upon the public highways of the State of Oregon.

Section II. All such vehicles mentioned in section I of this ordinance owned by nonresidents of the State of Oregon who shall have complied with the laws of the State of their residence relative to the display of registration number plates therein are relieved for a period of thirty days from compliance with the terms of this ordinance: provided that all such vehicles shall conspicuously display the state number thoreon of the state from which they come; and provided further that nothing in this ordinance shall be deemed to apply to traction engines, road rollers, fire wagons and fire engines.

Section III, Any person violating any of the terms of this ordinance unon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of the City of Albany shall be fined in a sum not to exceed \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the City jail not to exceed 10 days.
