## ORDINANCE NO. 925 25

BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTING A LATERAL SEWER ENGINEERS AT THE
MANHOLE IN THE OAD STREET TRUNK SEWER EXTENSE FIRST AND SECOND
STREETS AND RUNNING THENCE WESTERLY INTO BLOCK 7 HACKLEMAN'S
SED ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY A DISTANCE OF 272 THET, PROVIDING HOW THE COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENT SHALL BE FAID, THE PENALTY OR DAMAGE TO THE CITY OF ALBANY BY THE PERSON OR PERSONS
MAKING SUCH IMPROVEMENT IF THE BAYE BE NOT COMPLETED WITHIN THE
TIME AGREED UPON, AND THE GIVING OF A COOD AND SUFFICIENT BOND
POR THE FAITHPUL PERFORMED OF THE WORK OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT, AND
PROVIDING FOR THE CIVING OF PROPER NOTICE FOR BIDS FOR THE COMPLETION OF SAID IMPROVEMENT BY THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREG.

THE PROPLE OF THE CIYTO F ALBANY DO CADAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed an eight inch vitrified terra cotta sewer beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street Trunk Sewer between First and Second Streets and running thence Westerly into Block 7 in Hackleman's 3rd Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon a distance of 272 feet.

Asid improvement shall be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and estimates of the City Engineer of said City for the construction of said lateral sewer-on file in the office of the Recorder of said City Tuly 10th, 1918, and the said Engineer's plans and specifications for the construction of all lateral sewers connecting with Oak Street Trunk Sewer in the City of Albany, Tregon, filed in the office of the Pecorder of said City April 8th, 1914.

The cost of said lateral sever shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising out of the assessments to be made, ascertained and declared by ordinance on the lots and and parts of lots adjacent to said improvement so to be made and especially and particularly benefitted thereby as provided by the Charter of said City.

Said sewer shall be completed by the 1st day of October, 1918.

All bids submitted for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany, may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by said city for the making of said improvement shall before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make. execute and deliver to said City, a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient surety to be approved by the Mayer of the City of Albany in a sum equal to 50% of the total amount to be paid under such contract for the faithful performance of such contract.

exection 2. If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said City shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$10.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time so stated in said contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time for the completion of said improvement be extended by the Council.

Bection 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to immedately

give proper notice for bide for the making of maid improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Evening Democrat, a daily newspaper published in the City of Albany, fully discribing ir said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
