AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR ND RECORDER OF THE CITY
OF ALBANY. OREGON TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH W. A. MCGLAIN FOR
THE BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION OF A LATERAL SEWER BEGINNING AT THE
MAN-HOLE IN THE OAD STREET TRUNK SEWER BETWEEN FIRST AND SECOND STREETS
AND RUNNING THENCE WESTERLY INTO BLOCK 7 IN HACKLEMAN'S THIRD ADDITION
TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON A DISTANCE OF 272 FERT WITH VITHIFIED
TERMA COTTA SEWER PIPE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS
OF THE CITH KNOINEAR OF THE CITY OF ALBANY FOR SAID LATERAL SEWER
ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY JULY 10TH, 1918
AND THE SAID ENGINEER'S PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION
OF ALL LATERAL SEMERS CONNECTIVE WITH OAK STREET THIRTH SELER IN SAID
CITY, FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY,
APRIL 8,1914.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 4 of the City of Albany, Oregon, adopted by the Council on the 10th day of July, 1918, it was ordered that a lateral sewer be constricted beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street Trunk Sewer between First and Second Street and running thence Westerly into Block 7, in Hackleman's Third Addition to said City a distance of 272 feed, said improvement to be made in accordance with the plans and specifications of the City Engineer for said improvement them on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany, and

WHRHRAS, it was provided by Ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance, and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, according to said ordinance, on the 28th day of August, 1918.

W. A. McClain presented his bid to the Council of said city for the making of said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and by said ordinance, by which bid the said W. A. McClain proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement, for the sum of \$225.00; and

WHENEAS, W. A. McClain was the lowest bidder for said proposed work, and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor:

Therefore

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of the said W. A. McClain for said improvement be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are bre-by authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said W. A. McClain for the making of said improvement, as aforesaid, on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, and upon the terms and conditions in said ordinance, advertisement and bid hereinabove mentioned. Said contract shall provide that the work of said sewer shall commence within ten (10) days after the signing of said contract, and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or

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before the let day of October, 1918; and the city of Albany, Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$10.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time.

Said contract shall further provide that the said

W. A. McClain shall promptly, as due, make payment to all porsons supplying to the said W. A. McClain labor or material for the prosection of the horeinabove described work, and that the said W. A. McClain shall not permit my lien or claim to be filed or prosecuted against the City of Albany for or on account of any labor or material furnished for the said work.

The said W. A. McClain shall furnish a penal bond in the sum of \$113.00 with good and sufficient sureties approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, to secure the faithful performance of all the obligations of such contract on the part of the said W. A. McClain, and particularly agains t any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person arising out of said contract. .
