

ORDINANCE NO. 927.

AN ORDINANCE TO ASCERTAIN AND DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CONSTRUCTING A LATERAL SEWER WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON HAS DETERMINED BY RESOLUTION NO. 4 ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 10TH DAY OF JULY, 1918, BEGINNING AT THE MANHOLE IN THE OAK STREET TRUNK SEWER BETWEEN FIRST AND SECOND STREETS AND RUNNING THENCE WESTERLY INTO BLOCK 7 IN HACKLEMAN'S THIRD ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON A DISTANCE OF 272 FEET, TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROBABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT THAT IS ASSESSED UPON EACH LOT OR PART THEREOF, OR PARCEL OF LAND ADJACENT TO SAID IMPROVEMENT, TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIENS, AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS on the 10th day of July, 1918 the Council of the City of Albany duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the construction of a lateral sewer beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street Trunk Sewer between First and Second Streets and running thence Westerly into Block 7 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon a distance of 272 feet, and for estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and requiring such plans, specifications and probable cost to be filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, on or before the 10th day of July 1918, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 3, adopted July 10th, 1918", and

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 3 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said resolution for the construction of said lateral sewer in the manner therein specified and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 10th day of July, 1918, and

WHEREAS the Council on the 10th day of July, 1918 by Resolution No. 4 duly adopted by said Council determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient, and that said Council proposed to construct said lateral sewer beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street Trunk Sewer between First and Second Streets and running thence Westerly into Block 7 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 272 feet, as provided by the Charter of said City, and

WHEREAS the Recorder, in pursuance of said Resolution No. 4, gave due notice of said proposed improvement in the manner provided by the Charter of said City, and on the 28th day of August 1918, pursuant to said notice, W. A. McClain submitted his bid to the Council for the making of said improvement for the sum of \$225.00, which said bid was received and accepted by the Council in and by ordinance No. 926, passed by the Council August 28th, 1918, and approved by the Mayor August 28, 1918.

T H E R E F O R E

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an eight inch vitrified terra cotta sewer shall be constructed at the beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street Trunk Sewer between First and Second Streets and running thence westerly into Block 7 in Hackleman's Third Addition

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to the City of Albany, Oregon a distance of 272 feet, all in accordance with Resolution No. 4 of the Council of said City and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany on July 10, 1918.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany, in and by said Resolution No. 4 and by the bid of the said W. A. McClain is hereby declared to be the sum of \$249.01 and the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the owners of property adjacent to and particularly benefitted thereby is the sum of \$205.01.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of such probable cost of said improvement assessed on each lot or part thereof, or parcels or tracts of land adjacent to said improvements aforesaid, and as determined by said Council is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of said lots, or parts thereof, or parcels or tracts of land as follows, to-wit:

R. R. Knox and E. A. Johnson

Lot 1 Block 7 in Hackleman's Third addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, Assessed at-----\$25.63

Winona Williams

Lot 2 Block 7 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon Assessed at-----\$25.63

Blanchie Egan

Lots 3 and 4 in Block 7 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oreg. Assessed at-----\$51.25

R. B. and M. T. Miller

Lots 5 and 6 in Block 7 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, Assessed at-----\$51.25

Jennie E. Johnson

Lots 7 and 8 in Block 7 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon Assessed at-----\$51.25

Section 4. That the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon is hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of the assessments made and determined by this ordinance, together with the names of the respective owners of each lot, or parts thereof, or tracts or parcels of land adjacent to said improvement, hereinabove described, in the Docket of City Liens of the said City of Albany as provided by the Charter of said City.
