AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND MANNER OF INTROVING BALFM SALES ROAD FROM THE EAST LIME OF MAIN STREET TO THE CENTER OF GRARY STREET, PROVIDING HOW THE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT SHALL BE FAID, THE PENALTY OR DAYAGE TO THE CITY OF ALBANY BY THE PERSON OR PERSONS MAKING SUCH IMPROVEMENT IF THE SAME SHALL NOT BE COMPLETED WITHIN THE TIME AGREED UPON, AND THE GIVING OF A GOOD AND SUFFICIENT BOND FOR THE FAITH-FUL FERFORMANCE OF THE WORK OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID FART OF SAIL STREET, AND PROVIDING FOR THE GIVING BY THE HECORDER OF SAID CITY OF THO OF SAID STREET.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Salem Road from the East line of Main Street to the center line of Geary Street in the City of Alwany, Oregon, shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said Street to the proper subgrade.

Becond: By paving the roadway of said Street twenty feet in width with asphaltic, concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.

Third: By laying and constructing rock or gravel shoulders.

Fourth: By laying and constructing wood headers.

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of Engineer, John R. Penland, for the improvement of said Street, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon, on the 9th day of April, 1919, endorsed "Engineer's plans, and specifications for the improvement of Salem Road from the East line of Main Street to the center line of Geary Street and the estimate of the work to be done on said Street and the probable cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said portion of Salem Road shall be paid out of the assessment hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Alwany on the lote and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said Salem Road so to be improved, and especially and particularly benefited the: e-by, as provided by the charter of said city.

The said improvement of said portion of said Salem Road shall be completed by the 15 day of October, 1919.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said Street deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany, may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City for the making of saidimprovement shall, before commencing said inprovement, and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient surety, in the sum of Five thousand (\$5000.00) Dollars for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said Salem hoad shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of completion of said improve-

ment is extended by the Council.

Section 3. The recorder of said city is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of said Salem Road by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Daily Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said Salem Road.
