

ORDINANCE No. 236

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, TO VOTE UPON A MEASURE PROPOSED AND SUBMITTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY TO THE PEOPLE, PROVIDING HOW THE EXPENSES OF SUCH ELECTION SHALL BE PAID AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, by Resolution No. 10 adopted on the 16th day of May, 1919, proposed and submitted to the people for their approval or rejection a certain measure accepting a conveyance from H. Bryant and Adda E. Bryant his wife, of certain lands for park purposes, according to certain restrictions, reservations and conditions specified in said deed; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a special election be held at which said measure may be voted upon by the people prior to August 1, 1919.

T H E R E F O R E,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A special election shall be held in the several wards of the City of Albany on Tuesday, the 10th day of June, 1919, for the purpose of voting upon a measure proposed and submitted by the council of the City of Albany to the people for their approval or rejection, which said measure provides for the acceptance of a deed from H. Bryant and Adda E. Bryant, his wife, to the City of Albany, Oregon, a municipal corporation, conveying certain lands to be used for park purposes, subject to certain restrictions, reservations and conditions.

Section 2. At said special election, the polls shall be opened at the hour of eight o'clock A. M. and shall be closed at the hour of eight o'clock P. M. and said election shall be conducted and the votes shall be cast, counted, canvassed and returned in the manner provided by the charter of the City of Albany.

Section 3. All bills contracted to meet the expenses incident to the carrying into effect of this ordinance shall be audited and paid out of the general fund as other claims against the city are paid; and the recorder is hereby directed to give the proper notice of said election as provided by the charter of the City of Albany.

Section 4. It is hereby declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and that an emergency exists, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its approval by the Mayor.
