

ORDINANCE NO. 938.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND ESTABLISHING THE GRADES OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, in order that permanent sidewalks may be constructed and laid upon the proper grades and in certain portions of the city no grades have been established and

and WHEREAS it is necessary that the original establishment of certain grades be made;

T H E R E F O R E :

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following street grades are hereby established, which said grades shall be the respective number of feet indicated above the base of grades established by Ordinance No. 724 entitled "An ordinance fixing and establishing the grades of certain streets in the City of Albany, Oregon," passed by the Council May 13, 1914, and approved by the Mayor May 14, 1914, to-wit:

Ninth Street: at Willetta 53.3 feet; at a point 150 feet east of the east line of Cottage Street, 53.9 feet; at Cottage Street, 53.6 feet; at Liberty Street, 52.2 feet.

Tenth Street: At Willetta 51.6 feet; at a point 150 feet east of the east line of Cottage Street, 55.8 feet; at Cottage Street, 55.5 feet; at Liberty Street, 53.8 feet.

Eleventh Street: At Elm Street, 51 feet; at Willetta Street, 52.8 feet; at Cottage Street, 56.4 feet; at Liberty Street, 55.8 feet;

Twelfth Street: at Elm Street, 46 feet; at Willetta Street, 51.6 feet; at Penn Street, 54.8 feet; at Cottage Street, 54.5 feet; at Liberty Street, 56.7 feet.

Section 2. That the grades hereby established shall be held and construed to mean the top of the curb grade.
