ORDINANCE NO. 943

AN ORDINANCE TO ASCRATAIN AND DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORGON, HAS DETERMINED BY LESOLUTION NO.7, ADDITAD BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 23 DAY OF APRIL, 1919, TO MAKE ON FLAST STREET FROM THE WEST CURB LINE OF SHERMAN STREET TO THE EAST LINE OF PINE STREET; TO ASCRITAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLAID THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROBABLE COSTS OF SUCH IMPROVAMENT OF SAID FIRST STREET THAT IS ASSESSED UPON FARCH LOT ON THE ANT THEREOF ADJACENT TO SAID FART OF FIRST STREET TO BE SO IMPROVED; TO DIRECT THE RANDERDAR OF THE SAID CITY TO SAITER A STRUENT OF SUCH ASSESSIVE IT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIKES AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, on the 9 day of April, 1919, the Council of the City of Albany duly saleted a resolution requiring of Engineer John k. Fenland plans and specifications for the improvement of First Street and for estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of First Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office in said City, said resolution being indorsed "Resolution No. 5" and adopted the 3 day of April, 1919.

WHARKAS, the said Engineer John R. Penland made, plans, specifications and estimates by said Resolution for the improvement of said First Street in the manner specified in Resolution No. 5 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office in said City on the 23rd day of April, 1919; and

WHENEAS, the said Council on the 23rd day of April, 1919, by Resolution No.7 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve First Street from the west curb line of Sherman Street in the manner provided by said resolution so adopted on said 28th day of April, 1919; and

WHENEAS, in and by said Resolution No. 7, adopted as aforesaid by the Council the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said First Street from the west curb line of Sherman Street to the east line of Pine Street as provided by the charter of City, and

WHRRAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said First Street in the sanner provided by the charter of said City; and

WHENEAS, the said Council in and by said hesolution No. 7 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Salem hoad to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said First Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 7 to be the sum of \$1,5350

THERRFORE

THE PROPIN OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS POLLOWS:

Section 1. That First Street from the west curb line of Sherman Street to the east line of Pine Street in the City of Sherman Street to the east line of Pine Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 345.

By grading said street to the proper subgrade. First:

By paving the roadway of said street full width with asphaltic concrete pavenent on an asphaltic concrete foundation. Second:

Third: By constructing inlete.

Fourth: By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 7 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by Engineer John R. Penland with the Recorder of said City of Albany, on the 23rd day of April, 1919.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said First Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the west curb line of Sherman Street to the east line of Pine Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by Resolution No. 7, with asphaltic concrete payement to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of First Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$4,655.36.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said First Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of First Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by hesolution No. 7, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sun set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
