ORDINANCE NO. 563.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND VALUER OF BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTING A LATERAL SEWER BRGINNING AT THE END OF A TEN INCH LATERAL SEWEN, CONSCRING WITH THE BANKS STRUCT THANK SEWER, AT THE INTERSCRICT OF THE WEST LINE OF BAKER STRUCT AND THE CENTER OF THE ALLEY BETWEEN FOURTH AND FIFTH STREETS AND HUNNING THENCE WESTERLY THROUGH THE CONTER OF SID ALLEY THROUGH BLOCK 30 OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, A DISTANCE OF 665.5 FIRST THE WEST LINE OF ELLSWORTH STREET, FROVIDING NOW THE COST OF SUCH INSOUR-LERNT SHALL BE INDIE, THE ISLAND OR BANKS TO THE CITY OF ABBANY MY THE PERSON OR DEREONS MAKING SUCH INPROVEDENT, IF THE SAME BE NOT COMPILED WITAIN THE TIME ABREND UPON AND THE GIVING BY THE RESCRIBER OF MAIN THE OF ALBANY OF PROPER NOTICE FOR BILDS FOR THE COMPILETION OF SAID IMPROVEDENT.

THE PROPIE OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there shall be rebuilt and reconstructed in 10% lateral sewer beginning at the end of a ten inch lateral sewer, connecting with the Beker Street trunk sewer, at the intersection of the West line of Baker Street and the center of the alley between Fourth and Fifth Streets and running thence Westerly through the center of said alley through Block 5 of the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, and Block 30 of the City of Albany, a distance of 668.5 feet to the East line of Ellsworth Street;

Baid improvement shall be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of Engineer John R. Penland, of said City for the reconstruction of said lateral sewer filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 25th day of February, 1920.

The cost of laying said sever across intersecting Streets shall be paid out of the general fund of said City and the remaining portion of the cost of said lateral sever shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising out of the assessments to made, ascertained and declared by ordinance on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said improvement so to be made and especially and particularly benefited thereby as provided by the charter of said City.

The said sever shall be completed by the 1st day of July, 1920.

All bids for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the city for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make,
execute and deliver to raid city a good and sufficient bond with good and
sufficient surety to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in the
sum of \$1000.00 for the faithful performance of said contract.

Section 2. If the persons, firm or corporation entering into may contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement shall, not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of

\$2.50 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of soid City is hereby directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement by publishing such notice for ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
