ORDINANCE NO. 964.

AN ORDINANCE TO ASCERTAIN AND DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CONSTRUCTING A LATERAL SEWER WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORSON, HAS DETERMINED BY RESOLUTION NO. 17, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 25th DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1920, AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR ON THE 25th DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1920, BEGINNING AT THE END OF A TEN INCH LATERAL SEWER, CONNECTING WITH THE BAKER STREET TRUNK SEWER, AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE WEST LINE OF BAKER STREET AND THE CENTER OF THE ALLEY BETWEEN FOURTH AND FIFTH STREETS AND RUNNING THENCE WESTERLY THROUGH THE CENTER OF SAID ALLEY THROUGH BLOCK 5 OF THE EASTERN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, AND BLOCK 30 OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, A DISTANCE OF 668.5 FEET TO THE EAST LINE OF HILSWORTH STREET, TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROBABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT THAT IS ASSESSED UPON EACH LOT OR PART THEREOF, ADJACENT TO SAID IMPROVEMENT; AND TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIBRS AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, THE CITY ENGINEER IN PURSUANCE OF THE DIRECTIONS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY MADE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ABOVE DESCRIBED LATERAL SEWER, AND FILED SAID PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATES IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY ON THE 25th DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1920, AND

WHEREAS, THE COUNCIL ON THE 25th DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1920, BY RESOLUTION NO. 17, DULY ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL, DETERMINED AND RESOLVED THAT IT WISHED IT EXPEDIENT AND THAT SAID COUNCIL PROPOSED TO CONSTRUCT THE ABOVE DESCRIBED LATERAL SEWER; AND

WHEREAS, IN AND BY SAID RESOLUTION NO. 17, ADOPTED AS AFORESAID BY THE COUNCIL, THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY WAS DULY ORDERED AND DIRECTED BY SAID COUNCIL TO GIVE NOTICE OF SAID PROPOSED SEWER IMPROVEMENT AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY OF ALBANY, AND

WHEREAS, THE RECORDER IN PURSUANCE OF SAID ORDER AND DIRECTION OF THE COUNCIL OF SAID CITY OF ALBANY DID DULY GIVE NOTICE OF SAID PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT IN THE MANNER PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY; AND

WHEREAS, THE SAID COUNCIL IN AND BY SAID RESOLUTION NO. 17 ASCERTAINED AND DETERMINED THE TOTAL PROBABLE COST OF MAKING SAID IMPROVEMENT TO BE PAID BY THE OWNERS OF REAL PROPERTY ADJACENT TO SAID IMPROVEMENT AS MENTIONED IN SAID RESOLUTION NO. 17 TO BE THE SUM OF \$1,767.48, AND THE TOTAL PROBABLE COST OF MAKING SAID IMPROVEMENT TO BE THE SUM OF \$2,388.56.

T H E R E F O R E

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a ten inch lateral sewer shall be laid beginning at the end of a ten inch lateral sewer, connecting with the Baker Street trunk sewer, at the intersection of the West line of Baker Street and the center of the alley between Fourth and Fifth Streets and running thence Westerly through the center of said alley through Block 5 of the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, and Block 30 of the City of Albany, a distance of 668.5 feet to the East line of Hilsworth Street.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 17 is hereby declared to be the sum of \$2,388.56, and the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the property adjacent and especially and particularly benefited thereby is the sum of \$1767.28.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said

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improvement as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 17 is hereby ascertained and determined to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of said lots or parts thereof, as follows, to-wit:

Block 5 Eastern Addition.

All lines to run parallel with the boundary lines of said Block Assessed at	68.00

That the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of the assessment made and determined by this ordinance, together with the names of the respective owners of such lots, or parts thereof, hereinabove described, in the Docket of City Liens of the said City of Albany, as provided in the charter of said City.


