## ORDINANCE NO. \_965.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, TO ENTER MITO A COMPRACT WITH W. S. WEAVER FOR THE BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTING OF A LATERAL SEWER, COMMECTING WITH THE BAKER STREET THUKK SEVER, AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE WEST LINE OF EACHR STREET AND THE CRUTER OF THE ALLEY NETWORK FOURTH AND FIFTH STREETS AND RUMBING THENCE WESTRALY THROUGH THE CRUTER OF SAID ALLEY THROUGH BLO K B OF THE EASTARN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, AND BLOCK 30 OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, A DISTANCE OF 663.5 FREET TO THE TIST LINE OF ELLEWORTH STREET, LAYING A TEN MICH VITRIFIED TREAK COTTA SEWER PLYE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS OF ENGINEER JOHN R. HERLAND FOR SAID LATERAL SEWER FILED ON THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, TRESON, ON FEBRUARY 25th, 1920.

WHEREAS, BY RESOLUTION NO. 17, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBARY ON THE 25th DAY OF FWBRUARY, 1920, IT WAS ORDERED THAT THE ALGUE DESCRIBED LATERAL SHOWER BE CONSTRUCTED, SAID IMPROVEMENT TO BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHARTER AND ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ALBARY AND THE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATES OF THE CITY ENGINEER THEN ON FILE WITH THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBARY; AND

WHEREAS, AFTER DUE NOTICE AND ADVENTISEMENT FOR BIDS HADE AND COVEN BY THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY ACCORDING TO SAID ORDILANCE, ON THE 12th DAY OF MAY, 1900, W. S. WEAVER PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL OF SAID CITY HIS BID FOR MAKING SAID IMPROVEMENT, WHICH BID WAS MADE IN DUE FORM AND IN CONFORMITY WITH ALL THE CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY LAW AND BY SAID CHDIMANCE, BY WHICH SAID BID SAID W. S. WEAVER PROPOSED TO TURNISH ALL MATERIAL AND IMPLEMENTS AND FRETCRI THE LABOR MECHSSARY TO MAKE THE ABOVE DESCRIBED IMPROVEMENT FOR THE SUM OF \$2498.40; AND

WHEREAS, W. S. WEAVER VAS THE LOWEST BIDDER FOR SAID PORPOSED WORK, AND SAID BID WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST BID THEREFOR,

THEREFORE.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the said bid of said W. S. Weaver for said improvement, be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said W. S. Weaver for the making of said improvement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany, Cregon, upon the terms and conditions in said ordinance, advertisement and bid hereinabove mentioned. Said contract shall provide that the work on said sewer shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the lat day of July, 1020, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time.

Said contract shall further provide that the said W. S. Weaver shall promptly, as due, make payment to all persons supplying to the said W. S. Weaver labor or material for the prosecution of the hereinatove described work and that the said W. S. Weaver shall not permit any lien or claim to be filed or prosecuted against the City of Albany for or on account of any material or labor furnished for said work.

The said W. S. Weaver shall furnish a renal bond in the sum of \$1000.00, with good and sufficient surety, to be approved by the Mayor of

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the City of Albany, to secure the faithful performance of all the obligations of said contract on the part of said W. S. Weaver, and particularly against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person srising out of said contract.
