

ORDINANCE NO. 966.

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE FOUR HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$485.00) FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE FORD AUTOMOBILE FOR THE STREET DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF ALBANY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of Four Hundred and Eighty-five Dollars (\$485.00) for the purchase of one Ford automobile from the Pacific Garage for the street department of said city, and the Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the Street funds of said city, in favor of the said Pacific Garage, for the amount hereby appropriated.
