ORDINANCE NO. 1007.

AN ORDINANCE TO ASCERTAIN AND DETARMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORROON, HAS DETERMINED IN RESOLUTION NO. 17. ADOPTE BY SAID QUICIL ON THE STH DAY OF JUNE, 1921, TO MAKE ON ELLSWORTH STREET FROM THE NORTH LINE OF FIRST STREET TO THE SOUTH LINE OF WATER STREET IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORECON: TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROBABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID ELLSWORTH STREET THAT IS ASSESSED UPON EACH LOT OR PART THERE OF ADJACENT TO SAID PART OF ELLSWORTH STREET TO BE SO IMPROVED; TO DIRECT THE RECONDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIENS AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, on the 25th day of May, 1921, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring the City Engineer to make plans, and specifications for the improvement of Ellsworth Street from the Nosth line of First Street to the South line of Water Street in the following mahner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.

Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation, or by paving said street with Portland dement pavement, or paving said street with Warrenite bitulithic wearing surface upon a bituminous concrete base at the option of the Council.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of Ellsworth Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications said and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 14" and adopted the 25th day of May, 1921; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 14 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the improvement of Ellsworth Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No.14 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office in said City on the 8th day of June, 1921; and

WHEREAS, the said Council on the 8th day of June, 1921, by Resolution No. 17, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said council proposed to improve Ellswoth Street from the North line of First Street to the South line of Water Street in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 17; and

WHEREAS, in and by Resolution No. 17 adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said city was duly ordered and derected by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Ellsworth Street from the North line of First Street to the South line of Water Street as provided by the charter of said city; and

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Third Street in the manner provided by the charter of said city; and

15th,1921, did select Asphaltic concrete pavement on an Asphaltic concrete foundation as the most advantageous kind of pavement to be used in the making of said improvement as aforesaid; and

WHEREAS, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 17 secretainedand determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Ellsworth Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Ellsworth Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 17 to be the sum of \$ 3,160.50

THEREFORE

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Elleworth Street in the City of Albany, Oregon from the North line of First Street to the South line of Water Street shall be improved as follows:

First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.
Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 17 and Resolution No. 25 and the plans, and specifications for the improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 8th day of June, 1921.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Ells worth Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the North line of First Street to the South line of Water Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of the said City of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 17 with asphaltic concrete pavement. Portland cement concrete, pavement, or Warrenite pavement at the option of the Council to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Ellsworth Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$ 3160.50.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said cost of said improvement of said Ellsworth Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said put of Ellsworth Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 17 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placedimmediately after the separate description of each of such low or parts thereof as follows:
