

ORDINANCE NO. 1003.

AN ORDINANCE TO ASCERTAIN AND DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENT WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, HAS DETERMINED IN RESOLUTION NO. 11, ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 25th DAY OF MAY, 1921, TO MAKE ON THIRD STREET FROM THE WEST CURB LINE OF RAILROAD STREET TO THE WEST LINE OF MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON: TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROBABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID THIRD STREET THAT IS ASSESSED UPON EACH LOT OR PART THEREOF ADJACENT TO SAID PART OF THIRD STREET TO BE SO IMPROVED: TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE BOOKLET OF CITY LIENS AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of May, 1921, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring the City Engineer to make amended plans and specifications for the improvement of Third Street from the West curb line of Railroad Street to the West line of Main Street in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width, with full intersections with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation, or by paving said street with Portland Cement concrete pavement or Warrenite bitulitic wearing surface pavement upon a bituminous concrete base, at the option of the Council.
- Third: By laying and constructing wooden headers.
- Fourth: By constructing concrete curb.
- Fifth: By constructing catch basins.
- Sixth: By constructing inlets.
- Seventh: By laying sewer pipe.
- Eighth: By laying sub-drain tile.
- Ninth: By constructing monument cases.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of Third Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such amended plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 10" and adopted the 11th day of May, 1921; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 10 made amended plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the improvement of said Third Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 10 and filed said amended plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office in said City on the 25th day of May, 1921; and

WHEREAS, the said Council on the 25th day of May, 1921 by Resolution No. 11 duly adopted by said council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said council proposed to improve Third Street from the West curb line of Railroad Street to the West line of Main Street in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 11; and

WHEREAS, in and by Resolution No. 11 adopted as aforesaid by the Council the Recorder of said city was duly ordered and directed by said council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Third Street from the West curb line of Railroad Street to the West line of Main Street as provided by the charter of said City; and

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Third Street in the manner provided by the charter of said city; and

WHEREAS, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 23 adopted on July 15th, 1921 did select Asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation as the most advantageous kind of pavement to be used in the making of said improvement as aforesaid; and

WHEREAS, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 11 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Third Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Third Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 11 to be in the sum of \$ 25,000.00

T H E R E F O R E

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Third Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West curb line of Railroad Street to the West line of Main Street shall be improved as follows:

- First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with full inter sections with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.
- Third: By laying and constructing wooden headers.
- Fourth: By constructing concrete curb.
- Fifth: By constructing catch basins.
- Sixth: By constructing inlets.
- Seventh: By laying sewer pipe.
- Eighth: By laying sub-drain tile.
- Ninth: By constructing monument cases.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 11 and Resolution No. 23 and the amended plans and specifications for the improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 25th day of May, 1921;

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Third Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West curb line of Railroad Street to the West line of Main Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of the said City of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 11 with asphaltic concrete pavement, Portland cement concrete pavement, or Warrenite bitulithic pavement at the option of the Council to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Third Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$ 25,200.00

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said cost of said improvement of said Third Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Third Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 11 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:

DESCRIPTION OF EACH LOT OR PART THEREOF ADJACENT TO SAID IMPROVEMENT ON SAID THIRD STREET.


