AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION I, SECTION II AND SECTION VI OF ORDINANCE

160 556, ENTITLED * AM ORDINANCE TO ENLARGE THE DUTIES OF THE HUPPETOR OF

PRUMBING OF THE CITY OF ALBANY TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGISTRATION OF PER

SONS FIRMS AND CORPORATIONS REGAGED IN THE INSTALLING OF ELECTRIC APPLI
ANCES AND TO REGULATE ELECTRIC WIRING IN OR ON BUILDINGS, AWRINGS AND ADDITIONS TO ANY BUILDING, ALL WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON

AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR HON-COMPLIANCE, BASSED BY THE COUNCIL ON MAY

18T, 1913 AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR ON MAY 2nd, 1913; AS AMENDED BY ORDI
MANCE MO. 718, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL ON MARCH 25th, 1914 AND APPROVED BY THE

MAYOR ON MARCH 26th, 1914; AND AS FURTHER AMENDED BY ORDINANCE MO. 741, PASS

RD BY THE COUNCIL ON AUGUST 26th, 1914 AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR ON AUGUST

27th, 1914; THEREFORE

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That Sections I, II and VI of Ordinance No. 636 as amended by Ordinance No. 718, passed by the Council on March 25th, 1914 and approved by the Mayor on March 26th, 1914; and as further amended by Ordinance No. 741 passed by the Council on August 26th, 1914 and approved by the Mayor on August, 27th, 1914 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to introduce any electric lighting, hesting or power wire, circuit or circuits or apparatus in or on any building or awning, structure or addition thereof, within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Ore on, unless the same shall be in conformity with the rules and regulations set forth in what is known as the State Code covering installation of wires, and electrical equipment as published under the direction of the Bureau of Labor of the State of Oregon, as the same are now established, together with any amendments and chang as made from time to time, which code is adopted and approved. Before any such electric wiring shall be commenced in or on any building, awning, structure or addition thereto, a written permit must be obtained from the inspect or of said City authorizing the person, firm or corporation therein mamed to do and perform the electric wiring and designate the location where the same is to be performed. No such electric wiring shall be commenced as afore said until such permit has been obtained.

Section II. After any electric wiring shall have been completed in or on any building, awning, structure or addition thereto, for which a permit has been issued, the person or persons, firm or corporation who performed the same must immediately notify the inspector of the completion of the work and must keep said work open for inspection of said inspector to inspect the same and until he shall have examined and approved the same and insued a deratificate of such inspection. It shall be the duty of the inspector upon receiving said notice to inspect said electric wiring, and if the same has been per

formed in accordance with the rules and regulations as set forth in the State Code as hereinbefore mentioned, he must issue a dertificate to such effect; and deliver the same to the person, firm or corporation havinh done the wiring but if not performed in accordance with the said rules and requirements he shall withhold such certificate until all defects are remedied. The inspector shall inspect the work within 48 hours after receiving notice that work is ready for inspection.

Section III. All installations, changes, alterations, extensions or repairs hereafter made in electric installations, shall be done in accordance with the hereintefore mentioned rules of the said State Code.
