

ORDINANCE No. 1098

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE To ascertain and determine the probable cost of constructing a lateral sewer which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined by Resolution No. 27 adopted by the Council on the 11th. day of July, 1923, beginning at the manhole in Oak Street Trunk Sewer between Seventh and Eighth Streets and extending Westerly in the middle of Block 1, of D. D. Hackleman's Woodland Addition and Block 1, of Hackleman's Park Addition, a distance of 255 feet to the East line of the West tier of lots in said Block 1, of Hackleman's Park Addition in the City of Albany, Oregon; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the charter of said City.

WHEREAS, On the 11th. day of July, 1923, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of that portion of Block 1, in Hackleman's Woodland Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, lying West of Oak Street, if extended, and Block 1, in Hackleman's Park Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, by constructing a lateral sewer from a point where the manhole in the Oak Street sewer is situated and running thence in a Westerly direction along a line midway between the North and South boundary lines of said above described premises to a point which is the Southeast corner of Lot 1, in Block 1, in Hackleman's Park Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, in the following manner, to-wit:

1. By laying 255 feet of 8 inch sewer pipe;
2. By excavating and refilling;
3. By installing "Y" branches;
4. By installing "T" branches;
5. By installing lamp holes.

and for estimates of the work to be done in the construction of the above described lateral sewer and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's Office of said City, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 12" and adopted on the 13th. day of June, 1923, and

WHEREAS, The City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 12 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the above described improvement in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 12 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office in said City on the 11th. day of July, 1923, and

WHEREAS, The said Council on the 11th. day of July, 1923, by Resolution No. 27 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to construct the

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above described lateral sewer; and

WHEREAS, In and by said Resolution No. 27 adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed sewer improvement as provided by the charter of said City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, The Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed sewer improvement in the manner provided by the charter of said City, of Albany, and

WHEREAS, The said Council in and by said Resolution No. 27 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said improvement as specified in said Resolution No. 27, to be the sum of Five Hundred Thirty-six and Nineteen Hundredths Dollars (\$536.19).

T H E R E F O R E

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an Eight inch (8") lateral sewer shall be laid beginning at the manhole in Oak Street Trunk Sewer between Seventh and Eighth Streets and extending Westerly in the middle of Block 1, of D. D. Hackleman's Woodland Addition and Block 1, of Hackleman's Park Addition, a distance of 255 feet to the East line of the West tier of Lots in said Block 1, of Hackleman's Park Addition in the City of Albany, Oregon, in the following manner, to-wit:

1. By laying 255 feet of 8 inch sewer pipe;
2. By excavating and refilling;
3. By installing "Y" branches;
4. By installing "T" branches;
5. By installing lamp holes.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 27 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, on the 11th. day of July, 1923.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of the said City of Albany, Oregon, in and by said Resolution No. 27, by laying 255 feet of 8 inch sewer pipe, by excavating and refilling, by installing "Y" branches; by installing "T" branches and by installing lamp holes, to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said improvement and especially and particularly benefited thereby is the sum of Five Hundred Thirty-six and Nineteen hundredths Dollars (\$536.19).

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement as aforesaid and as determined by said council in and by said Resolution No. 27 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows, to-wit:

That the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of the assessment made and declared by this ordinance together with the names of the respective owners of such lot or part thereof hereinabove described in the Docket of City Liens of the said City of Albany, as provided in the charter of said City.
