ORDINANCE NO. 1210

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE regulating the parking of vehicles on Second Street between Broadalbin Street and Ferry Street in the city of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances, so far as this ordinance is concerned, in conflict herewith, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, The fire apparatus of the first department of the City of Albany, Linn county, Oregon, is kept in the city Hall Building, which is situated on the South side of Second Street between Broadslbin Street and Ferry Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, The parking of vehicles and the manner in which they are parked is of vital concern to the efficient operation of the fire department of the city of albany, Linn County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, The ingress and egress to said city Hall Building is impaired by the parking of automobiles near the entrance to the City Hall Building wherein the said fire apparatus is kept.

THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to perk any vehicle on Second Street between Broadalbin Street and Ferry Street in the City of Albany, Linn Lounty, Oregon, on the South side of said portion of said street a distance of fifty (50) feet from either side of the fire hall situated in the City Hall Fuilding in the City of Albany, Linn Lounty, Oregon.

Section 11. That it shall be unlawful for any person firm, or corporation to park any vehicle on Second Street between Broadalbin Street and Ferry Streetin the City of Albany, Oregon, in any manner except as follows:

Any motor vehicle parked on said portion of said street must be so parked that no part of said vehicle shall project over a distance of seven (7) feet from the curb line of said street toward the center of said portion of said street.

Section III. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of said City for each and every offense, be fined in a sum not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nora more than Twenty Dollars or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than two (2) days nor more than Ten days.

Section IV. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith only insofar as the same affects the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section V. WHEREAS, It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the reople of the City of Albeny that the foregoing ordinance be

immediately in morce and therefore an emergency exists and one is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
