ORTHWINGE NO. 111

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE to license and regulate hawkers and peddlers in the city of Albany, Oregon and defining what shall constitute a hawker and a peddler and providing a penalty for the violation thereof, and repealing Ordinance No. 593, entitled "An Ordinance to license and regulate hawkers and peddlers within the city of Albany, Oregon, and defining what shall constitute a hawker and a peddler and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith" passed by the Council on June 26th. 1912 and approved by the Mayor on June 26th. 1912" and declaring an emergency.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Hawkers shall pay a license of \$50.00 per.day for each day, they shall conduct their business within the corporate limits of the City of Albany. Any person who offers goods for sale by outcry upon the streets shall be deemed a hawker within the meaning of this ordinance.

Section 2. Peddlers shall be classified and rated as follows:
when traveling with two or more horses, first class: When traveling with one
horse, second class; When traveling on foot, third class. Peddlers of the
first class shall pay a license of \$15.00 per month, or \$25.00 per quarter.
Peddlers of the second class shall pay a license of \$12.00 per month, or
\$20.00 per quarter. Peddlers of the third class shall pay a license of
\$10.00 per month, or \$15.00 per quarter, provided that no peddler shall be
permitted to travel from place to place on First Street from Baker to Calapooia
Streets; on Second Street from Baker to Calapooia Streets, and on intervening
streets and Lyon Street from First to Tenth Street, and no peddler shall be
permitted to take his stand in front of or adjacent to any property within the
City of Albany, except by the consent of the occupant of such property.

Section 3. Any person who sells or offers for sale at retail, books, merchandise, notions, pictures, works of art, weres or commodities of any kind upon the streets or traveling from place to place in the City of Albany shall be deemed and regarded a pediler under this ordinance; provided, that this ordinance shall not apply to persons offering for sale, or selling newspapers, bibles or religious tracts or to farmers, gardeners or dairyment selling the products of their farms, gardens, or milk ranches; and provided further, that a permit may be issued to any peddler of the third class, who may be physically unable to perform manual labor, or to any woman residing in this City, who by peddling maintains, either herself or family or both, such permit to be issued by the City Recorder, upon the applicant for such permit filing with Recorder a recommendation, signed by the committee on ligenses, authorizing and directing the Recorder to issue such permit.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Any person or persons, violeting the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, for each and every such offense, be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) or by imprisonment in the City Jail not less than two days, nor more than twelve days.
