

ORDINANCE NO. 1121

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE To repeal Ordinance No. 1082 entitled "An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Broadalbin Street from the north line of First Street north to the south line of Water Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said part of said street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice for bids for the completion of such improvement of said part of said street and declaring an emergency" passed by the Council on July 25th, 1923 and approved by the Mayor on July 26th, 1923.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1082 passed by the Common Council on July 25th, 1923 and approved by the Mayor on July 26th, 1923 be and the same is hereby repealed.
