A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE Authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with Guy F. Pyle for the improvement of Sieventh Street from the West line of Ferry Street West to the East line of Calapocia Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, By Ordinance No. 1130 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: Eleventh Street from the West line of Ferry Street West to the East line of Calapocia Street, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
 By paving said street full width with Portland coment concrete pavenent, or by raving said street full width with 2 inch warrenite bitulithic wearing surface ravement on a 3 inch black base, or by paveing said street full width with a 2 inch warrenite bitulithic wearing surface pavenent on a 4 inch compressed crushed rock base, or by raving said street full width with 2 inch Warrenite bitulithic wearing surface pavement on a 4 inch compressed crushed gravel or gravel base.
- By laying paving headers.
 By laying 6 inch vitrified sewer pipe.
- By constructing inlets. By tapping sewers.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans, specifications and estimates of Engineer Charles H. Leonard, then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany; and

WHERFAS. It was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, After due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany, according to law end the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit: on the 9" day of July, 1924, Guy F. Pyle presented to the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, a bid for making said improvement with 2" Warrenite Bitulithic wearing surface pavement on a 3" black base which bid was made in due form and. in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council by which said bid Guy F. Pyle proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with 2" Werrenite Bitulithic wearing surface pavement on 3" black base for the following named prices, to-wit:

AND, WHEREAS, Said Cuy F. Pyle was the lowest responsible bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor, and WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, did in and by Resolution No. 27 heretofore duly and regularly adopted has designated and selected as the type of improvement to be made on said Street the following described: 2 inch Warrenite Bitulithic wearing surface payement on 3 inch black base.

Section 1. That the bid of Guy F. Pyle for said improvement of said described portion of Eleventh Street with 2 inch Marrenite Bitulithic wearing surface pevement on 3 inch black base be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in wirting with the said Guy F. Pyle for the making of said improvement with 2 inch Warrenite Bitulithic resping surface pavement on 3 inch black base on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms in said bid hereingbove mentioned.

Section 2. Said Contract to provide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within teh days after the signing of said contract and shell be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the lst. day of Cotober, 1924, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of Ten Dollars (\$10) per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond saidspecified time, and that Guy F. Pyle furnish a bond in a sum equal to Fifty per cent (50%) of the proposal of the contractor, to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, having as surety some surety company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performence of said contract on the part of Guy F. Pyle and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or meterial on the part of the person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.

Section 3. WHERFAS, IT is necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany that the foregoing improvement be immediately constructed and therefore an emergency exists and one is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
