ORDINANCE NO. 1253

A HILL FOR AN ORDINATED providing for the time and manner of making an improvement in the City of Albany by constructing a latteral sewer, beginning at s point on the Oak Street sever which would be intersected by the center line running east and west through block 13 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and Block 2 in H ackleman's Fourth Addition to the City of, Albany. Oregon, to the east line of said block 2 in said Hackleman's Fourth Addition to the City of Albert, Oregon, andistance of 512 feet; providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons, firm or corporation, making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of ' such improvement of said part of the above described portion of the C ity of Albany, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice for bids for the completion of such improvement, and declaring an emergency.

THE FROMLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDANI AS FOLLOWS: --

Sedtion 1. That the improvement of Block 13 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregan, and Block 2 in Hackleman's Fourth addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, from a point beginning on the Oak Street sewer which would be intersected by the center line running east and west through Block 13 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and B lock 2 in Hackleson's Pourth Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, to the wast line of Bick 2 in said Hacklenn's Fourth Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 612 feet, shall be made in the following sanger, to-wit:

- By laying 580 lineal feet of 3 inch sewer pipe.
- By excavating and refilling. By installing 1 lamp hols.

- By installing 1 can hole. By installing 16 8-inch Y's.

Sail'improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the C ity of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of Engineer Charles H. Leonard for the improvement of Block 13 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and Block 2 in Hackleman's Fourth Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, filed in the office of the necorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 12th day of Hovember, 1924, endorsed "Flans and Epecifications for Construction of B-inch latteral sewer in B lock 17, Knoklemon's Third Addition, and Block 2 in HackleHan's fourth Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon."

The cost of said improvement of said blocks in Heckleman's Third and Fourth Additions to the City of Albany shall be paid out of the funds collected and artains upon and out of the assaugation therewifer to be made, ascertained and dem clared by the Council of the City of Albany, on the lots and parts of lobe rdjacent to said improvement, and especially and particularly benefited the "to as provided by the charter of said City.

The soid improvement of said blocks in Hackleman's Third and Fourth Addi-

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tions to the Sity of Albany shall be completed by the first day of March, 1925.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said blocks 13 and 2 in Hacklesen! . Third and Fourth Additions; respectively, to the City of Albany may be rejested.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the f ity of Albany for the making of said improvement, shall at the time of sizning such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient surety in a sum not less than fifty per cent (50%) of the proposal of the contract conditioned upon the faithful performance of this contract.

Section 2. If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany, to make said improvement of said block 13 to Hackleman's Third Addition and block 2 in Hackleman's Fourth Addition to the City of Albany, shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$10.00 (Ten Mollars) per day for each and every day the completion of said williams is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion, unless the time of completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of block 13 in Wackleman's Third addition and block 2 in Wackleman's Fourth Addition Boundar Machiner to the City of Albany, Oregon, by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Daily Democrat, a daily newspaper published in said City of Albany, fully describerain said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.

Section 4. WHEREAR, it is necessary for the public health, peace and safety of the people of the city of Albany that the foregoing described improvement be immedistely constructed, and, therefore, an emergency exists and one is hereby decasred to exist, and this ordinance shall so into full force and effect immedistely upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
