## ORDINANCE NO.... 1181

AN ORDINANCE providing for the time and manner of improving Second Street from the west line of Cleveland Street to the mest line of Geary Street in the city of Albany, Oregon, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, what the penalty or damage to the city of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement shall be if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bend for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said portion of said etreet, and providing for the giving of notice by the Recorder of said City for bids for the completion of such improvement of said portion of each atreet.

THE PAOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Second Street from the west line of Cleveland Street to the west line of Geary Street, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, shall be improved in the following manner, towit:

1st. By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.
2nd. By surfacing the rosaway of said street 12 feet wide with gravel.
3rd. By laying sub-drain tile.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and cetimates of Charlee H. Leonard, City Anginser of said City, for the making of said improvement, which said plans, specifications and estimates were filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 11th day of March, 1925, endorsed: "Plans and Specifications for the Improvement of 2nd Street from the west line of Cleveland to

the west line of Geary Street in Albany, Oregon. The cost of the making of said improvement of said portion of said Second Street shall us paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the sessements hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said Second Street so to be improved, and especially and particularly benefitted thereby

as provided by the charter of the City said City.

Said improvement of said portion of Second Street shall be completed by the

first day of August, 1925.
All bids for the making of said improvement of said Street deemed unrea-

sonable by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, may be rejected.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the making of said improvement, shall before the commencement of the same and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient surety thereon in the sum of FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS, (\$400.00) conditioned for the faithful performance of such contract.

If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract Section 2. with the City of Albany to make said improvement of said Second Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of IN FIVE and no/100 DOLLARS (35.00) per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by said contractor doing the work at the completion thereof unless the time of the completion of such improvement be extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of Second Street, by publishing said notice ten (10) days in the Albany-Democrat-Hereld, a daily newspaper published in the City of Albany, Ore on, fully describing in such notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of eard Street.
