ORDINANCE NO. 1188

An Ordinance previding for the time and manner of improving Seventh Street from the Mast line of Denver Street to the south curb line of Santiam Hoad, in the City of Albany, Oregon, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, what the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement shall be if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said portion of said Street, and psoviding for the giving of notices by the Recorder of said City for bids for the completion of such improvement of said Street.

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY DO ORDAIN AS FOLIOUS:

Section 1. That Seventh Street from the East line of Denver Street to the south curbline of Santiam Road, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

1st: By grading said Street to the proper sub-grade
2nd: By surfacing the roadway of said Street 12 feet wide with gravel,

2nd: By surfacing the readway of said Street 12 feet wide with gravel, said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordiginamances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of Charles H. Leenard, City Mingineer of said City, for the making of said improvement, which said plans, specifications and estimates were filed in the effice of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 27th day of May, 1925, endorsed: "Plans and Specifications for the Improvement of 7th Street from the Mast line of Denver Street to the south durp line of Santiam Road, in Albany, Oregon."

The cost of the making of said improvement of said portion of said Seventh Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessment hereafter to be made, ascertained and icclared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said SeventhStreets to be improved and especially and particularly benefited thereby,

SeventhStreeted to be improved and especially and particularly benefited thereby,

as provided by the charter of said City.

Said improvement of said portion of Seventh Street shall be completed by

the first day of September, 1925.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said Street isemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, may be rejected.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the making of said improvement shall, before the commencing of the same, and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient surety thereon, in the sum of TWO HUNDARD DOLLARS (\$200.00) conditioned for the faithful arrounded of such contract. performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering in to any contract with the City of Albany to make said improvement of said Seventh Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer immages on account thereof to the amount of FIVE AND no/100 DOLLARS (\$5,00) per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in said contract, which amount shall be paid by said contractor doing the work at the completion thereof unless the time of the completion of such improvement be etextended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice of bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of Seventh Street, by publishing such notice ten (10) days in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a daily newspaper published in the City of Albany, Oregon, fully describing in such notice the time and manner of joing the work of said improvement of said Street.
