ORDINANCE NO. 1290

AM ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with U.G. Hayne for the improvement of Seventh Street from the east line of Denver Street to the south curb line of Santiam Road, in the City of Albany, by grading and graveling the same.

WHEREAS, by ordinance No. 1188 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following Street in said City be improved, to-wit: Seventh Street from the sast line of Denver Street to the south ourb line of Santiam Rosd, but in the following manner, to-wit:

let: By grading said Street to the proper sub-grade;
2nd: By surfacing the rosdway of said Street 12 feet wide with gravel;
3rd: By laying sub-grade tile;
Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinance of

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the Recordes of said City; and

WHEREAS, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of said City give notice of the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law, and in each ordinance, and

WHRHRAR, after due notice for bias made and given by the mecorder of the City of Albany according to the law and the ordinance aforesaid, to-wit: on the Sth day of July, 1925, U.G Hayne presented to the Council of the City of Albany his bid for making said improvement, which said bid was, and is, in due form, and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid the said U.G. Hayne proposed to furnish all material and implements and to perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the following named prices, to-wit:

122 cubic yards of excavation, (without classification)
at \$1.10 per yard

\$134.20

101 cubic yards gravel, # 91.45 per cubic yard

And, WHEREAS, said U.G. Hayne was the lowest and best bidder for said proposed work, and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor,

THEMENAR

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of U.G. Hayne for said improvement of said described portion of Seventh Street be, and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mavor and the Recorder of the said City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said U.G. Hayne for the making of said improvement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract shall provide that the work of said improvement shall commence within tenders after the signing of said contract, and shall be prosecuted with such vizor that all the work embraced within said contract shall be completed on or before the first may of september, 1920, and the City of Alberty shall be desired to suffer damages to the extent of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per day for such and every day suon work is delayed beyond such specified time, and that the said U.G. Hayne sail furnish a bond in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of said U.G. Hayne, and further indemnsfying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for lapor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.

Baction 2. That in order to preserve the public health and safety of the City of Albany an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and upon approval by the Mayor.
