## ORDINANCE NO. 1198

AN ORDINANCE to secertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined to make in Resolution No. 17 adopted by said Council on the 27th day of Hay, 1925, on Seventh Street from the east line of Denver Street to the south curb line of Santiam Road, in the City of Albany, Oregon; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said portion of said Street, that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof, adjacent to said portion of Seventh Street to be so improved; to authorize and direct the Recorder of said City, to enter a statement of such assessment in the docket of City Liens, as provided by the charter of said City; and declaring an emergency. d proposed n the manner charter and said City; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, On the 27th day of May, 1925, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring Charles E. Leonard, Engineer to compile and file in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 27th day of May, 1925, phans, specififcations and estimates of the probable cost of taking the improvement of Seventh Street in said City from the east line of Denver Street to the south surb line of Santiam Road, by grading and one continue the same; and

WHEREAS, said Engineer, pursuant to said Resolution, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed thereby for the improvement of said Resolution for the improvement of said City, on the 27th day of May, 1925, and

WHEREAS, the Council of said City, on the 27th day of May, 1925, by
Resolution No. 17, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that the council proposed to improve Seventh

Street from the east line of Denver Street to the south ourb line of Tantiam of Road in said City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner provided in said Resolu-

WHITE AR. by ordinance No. 1188 after due notice of the time and in the manner provided by law, the old of U.G. Hayne for the making of the said improvement of said portion of Seventh Street was accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany were thereby authorized to enter into a contract with U G Hayne for the making of said improvement in accordance with said bid, by grading and graveling said portion of said Street, and in other respects in accordance with said desolution No. 17.

## THEREFORS

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLIOUS:

Section 1. That Seventh Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the east line of Denver street to the south curb line of Santiam Hoad shall be improved as follows:

1st: By grading said etreet to the proper sub-grade; 2nd: By surfacing the roadway of said street 12 feet wide with gravel. 3rd: By laying sub-drain tile;

All in accordance with said assolution No. 17, and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by Charles H. Leonard, City angueer, with the Recorder of the City of Alsany, Oregon, on the 27th day of Lay, 1925.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Seventh Street, from the east line of Denver Street to the south curb line of Santiam Road, in said City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner heretofore determined by the Council, and in and by said Resolution No. 17, to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Seventh Street, is hereby declared to be the sum of THREE HERDERD TWENTY-THREE anim26/100 DOLLARS (5823.26).

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Seventh Street, assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said nortion of Seventh Street to be improved as aforesaid, and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 17, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots, or parts thereof, as follows:
