## ORDINANCE NO. 1199

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with W.S. Weaver for the builting and construction of a lateral sewer, beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street trunk sewer, between Sixth and Seventh Streets and running thence westerly through block two (2) and into block one (1) in Hackleman's Heirs' First Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 578 lineal feet, by laying, mystatianger 8 inch sewer pips in accordance with the plans and specifications of Charles H. Leonard, Engineer, of the City of Albany, Oregon, for said lateral sewer, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City Hay 13, 1925.

WHEHEAS, by resolution No. 13, of the City of Albany, Oregon, adopted by the Gouncil May 13, 1925, it was ordered that a lateral sewer be constructed, beginning at the manhols in the Oak Street trunk sewer, between Sixth and Seventh Streets, and running thence westerly through Block Two (2) and into Block One (1), a distance of 578 lineal feet, in Hackleman's Heirs First Addition to said City, by laying an 8 inch sewer pipe, in accordance with the plans and spedifications of Charles H. Leonard, Engineer of the City of Albany, for said lateral sewer, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City May 13, 1925, and

WHEKAS, it was provided by ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance, and

WEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids, made and given by the
Redorder of said City of Albany, Oregon, according to said ordinance, on the 10th
day of June, 1925, W.S. Weaver presented his bid to the Council of said City for the
making of said improvement, which said bid was made in due form and in conformity
with all the conditions imposed by law and by said ordinance, by which bid the said
W.S. Weaver proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform all the labor
necessary to make the above described improvement, for the sum of 3743.44, and

WEREAS, said W.S. Weaver was the lowest bidder for said proposed work, and said
bid was the lowest and best bid therefor.

bid was the lowest and best bid therefor,

THRREPORT, THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of said W.S. Weaver for said improvement be, and the same, is hereby accepted, and the mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorised and directed to enter into a contract in writing with the said W.S. Weaver for the making of said improvement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany, Orand upon the terms and conditions in said ordinance, advertisement and bid hereinabove mentioned. Said contract shall provide that the work of said sewer shall commence within ten (10) days after the signing of such contract, and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of october, 1925, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of PIVE DOLLARS (5.00) per day

for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time.

Said contract shall further provids that the said W.S. Weaver shall promptly
as due make payment to all persons supplying to the said W.S. Weaver labor or material
for the prosecution of the hereinahove described work, and that the said W.S. Weaver shall not permit any lien or claim to be filed, or prosecuted, against the City of Albany, for, or on account of, any labor or material furnished on account of said

work. Said W.S. Weaver shall furnish a penal bond in the sum of FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$450.00), with good and sufficient surety thereon, to be approved by the payor for the City of Albany, Oregon, to secure the faithful performance of all the obligations of such contract on the part of the said W.S. Weaver, and particularly on account of any lien or claim for labor or material furnished on the part of any person arising out of said contract.
