

ORDINANCE No. 1220

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$633.33 from the street fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, to pay the cost of making certain repairs by W.S. Weaver upon the piers and embankments of the Calapooia bridge in said City, and declaring an emergency.

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated of the Street Fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of \$633.33 for the purpose of paying the cost of certain repair work made by W.S. Weaver upon the piers and embankment of the Calapooia bridge in said City of Albany, and the Recorder of said City is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on said fund, payable to the said W.S. Weaver in the sum hereby appropriated.

Section 2. That, WHEREAS, the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.


