

ORDINANCE NO. 1236

AN ORDINANCE making, determining, declaring and levying a tax for the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the current assessment made upon the taxable property of said City for the year 1926, and to separately appropriate for each officer, department, building, structure, institution, bridge, highway, street and other purposes, the amount of the taxes so levied:

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, does hereby make, determine, declare and levy the amount of taxes in and for the City of Albany, Oregon, based upon the assessment of the taxable property in said City for the year 1926 and the taxes to be collected in the year 1927, in said City, as follows, to-wit:
