

ORDINANCE NO. 1342

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars of the General Fund of the City of Albany in payment of the purchase price of 500 feet of fire hose.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated of the General Fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700.00) for the purpose of making the purchase of Five Hundred (500) feet of fire hose from the Bureka Fire Hose Manufacturing Company.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to draw a warrant against the General Fund of said City payable to Bureka Fire Hose Manufacturing Company in the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700.00) and to deliver said warrant to said drawee.
